Information on the Planetary Ocean Reserves of Light Project (PORL)

Why Ocean Reserves of Light?

The Planetary Cities of Light project decided to expand the concept of making sacred cities and neighborhoods to the oceans. The idea is to create ocean reserves of light similar to planetary cities of light.

The oceans are in crisis, and in need of special sacred energies due to the extreme contamination of pollutants with the possibility of the collapse of all sea life due to the abuse of mankind. The PORL project acknowledges the ocean as a living organism and spirit that requires a spiritual intervention to protect and preserve it as sacred for humanity's survival on the planet. Finally, the PORL becomes part of a network like the PCOLs' in this case a network of higher vibrational spiritual, sacred ocean reserves of light.

What is a Planetary Ocean Reserve of Light?

The Planetary Ocean Reserves of Light are designated sacred areas in the ocean, shorelines, waterways, and coastal areas around the globe that are protected and capable of holding 5th dimensional light energy, and connected in a global network.

Group of Forty (GOF) members would identify a small area that they would like protected and that they will work with regularly to raise its vibration. The best and ideal is that it be an area close for them to visit whether it be a beach/shoreline or waterway, so that they may be able to interact with it on a constant basis. Like the Planetary City of Light, it will require a continual ongoing activation of energy and participation to maintain and hold the energy.

What are the requirements to create a Planetary Ocean Reserve of Light?

The key ingredient is your enthusiasm and desire to have a PORL. The format and process for creating a PORL is very similar to that of the PCOL. This time, the area chosen is a body of water with a shoreline that you can go to and interact with, by swimming or visiting. You will need a minimum of 3 registered GOF members preferably more living close to the area. When this is done you submit an application to the international coordinator and it will be reviewed by the PCOL Advisory Committee. Once approved, a mutually acceptable date will be set for its activation.

How is a Planetary Ocean Reserve of Light activated?

Prior to the activation we would ask that the group plant crystals in the designated area and that they meet as a group for the activation. However, it is not necessary to plant crystals in the water. If possible, you can plant the crystals on the shoreline, or if not possible you can put them in the

water or throw them in the water. The important thing is to visualize the light in the area. The group would then connect via telephone or computer to a conference line to other GOF members around the globe for an activation ceremony. In the ceremony a corridor of light and a stream of light is placed around the perimeter of the area raising it to the 5th dimension. This, in a sense, helps to purify the energy and make sure that the energy is "5th dimensional". The 5th dimension is the higher realm where there is unity consciousness, love and only higher thought vibrations. So after purifying the energy field of the Planetary Ocean Reserve of Light, it is then brought back down into the designated spot and the ocean reserve is officially activated.

Once the ocean reserve is activated, the initial activation energies must be maintained through regular (weekly or monthly) group meditations and activities. This requires commitment and discipline from the group.

How big should the Planetary Ocean Reserve of Light be?

It is recommended that initially the area designated for the Ocean Reserve be small. We want to create the most powerful, highest frequency of light. The Arcturians work with the concept of holographic energy where what happens in one part of an area, affects the whole. In the case of the Ocean Reserve a small area holding the highest light that is contained and strong can be sent out by osmosis traveling and having its intended effect through the whole ocean.

Can I choose an area that has been contaminated as an Planetary Ocean Reserve of Light?

Yes, you can choose an area that has contamination. You will help accelerate the healing of the area by your Planetary Ocean Reserve of Light work. At one time the area was not contaminated and at one time in the future there will be no contamination in the area. So, in your work expand your sense of time and see the area in the present, past and future.

How many Planetary Ocean Reserves of Light are there in GOF and where are they located?

As of June, 2021 the GOF currently has 13 PORL's in 7 countries on 4 continents.

In North America, in the United States we have one in Stuart on the east coast of Florida and another on the east side of Puerto Rico in Punta Figuera.

In South America in Argentina, we have one in Peninsula Valdez south of Buenos Aires. We have 3 PORL's in Brazil in Rio de Janeiro, Fortaleza and Salvador.

In Europe we have 3 PORL's; two in Spain in Barcelona and Valencia and another in the Black Sea in Romania.

In Australia we 3 PORL's in Mornington Peninsula, Melbourne and Sydney Harbor. In New Zealand we have a PORL in East Auckland.
